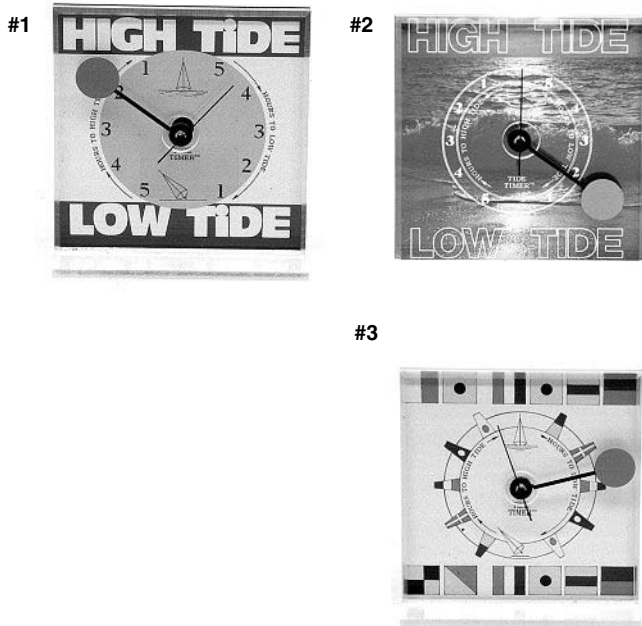


The Tide Timer™

Swing and a Miss Guy Harvey Clock

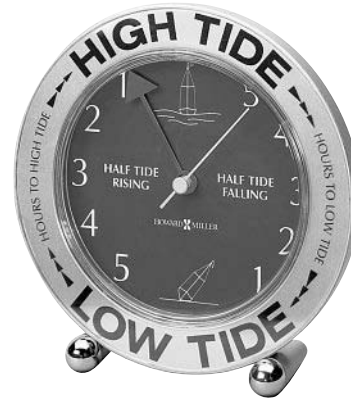
- This round table clock features the incredible maritime art of Guy Harvey, titled "Swing and a Miss" housed in a silver-tone case.
